Again this school year, we will be offering an A la Carte Menu for students separate from the lunch menu. This program is NOT to replace a lunch or items on the menu, but to offer additional items for students to have during lunch. Items sold will be within the USDA guidelines for school snacks. Students will be able to pay cash or charge their lunch accounts - per written permission. The program will begin Monday Aug. 27, 2018.

STUDENT CHARGE ACCOUNTS

Please read and explain to your child(ren) **before** school begins what choice the family has made when it comes to charging, or not charging, the Student Lunch Accounts. The first business day of every month, the previous month's charges will be posted to FACTS, and then deducted for your bank accounts on the 10th of the month. What happens if your child forgets their lunch? If a child forgets a lunch – they **WILL** receive a lunch even if they do not have written permission. Parents/guardians will be responsible for paying for this meal.

Students who do not have a drink for the day will be offered to charge milk or be given a cup to get water from the water fountain. Students with signed permission to charge will be offered this choice. If signed permission is not given, then only water will be offered to your child.
